

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

"SZÉCHENYI ISTVÁN UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP"

(Academic Year 2025/2026)

With the targeted financial support of the Széchenyi István University Foundation, the Board of Trustees of the UNIVERSITAS-Győr Foundation hereby announces a call for applications for a STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP for full-time students of Széchenyi István University

Eligible Applicants:

Full-time students of Széchenyi István University enrolled in Bachelor's, Master's, or undivided (one-tier) degree programmes, who demonstrate exemplary performance through outstanding Scientific Students' Associations (TDK) activity.

Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Hold active student status at Széchenyi István University (SZE) in the semester of application submission*
- Have completed at least two active semesters immediately preceding the current application phase*, with a minimum scholarship average of 3.50
- Have completed a minimum of 50 credit points*
- Hold at least one intermediate-level (Type A and B, or Type C) language examination certificate*
- Have either:

participated in the National Scientific Students' Associations Conference (OTDK) in the academic year of the call (2025/2026) or the preceding two academic years (2024/2025 or 2023/2024), OR

achieved 1st-3rd place or a special award at the institutional TDK in the academic year of the call or the preceding academic year (A special award refers to the official special award issued by the institution, not special awards provided by sponsors!)**

Advantages During Evaluation:

The following will be taken into account as additional merits:

- Participation in teaching or research activities at SZE**
- Additional language proficiency beyond the basic requirement*
- Active membership in a College for Advanced Studies (Szakkollégium) lasting more than 1 academic year and still active at the time of application submission**
- Publication activity**

Additional Considerations:

During the evaluation process, the reviewing committee will take into account any other scholarships received by the applicant, which must be declared at the time of application. The committee aims to ensure that the scholarship is awarded to as wide a range of students as possible; therefore, preference will be

given to applicants who are not receiving other scholarships. A scholarship can only be awarded once for a specific OTDK/TDK paper.

Number of Awardees:

The scholarship will be awarded to **20 students** per semester.

Scholarship Amount:

Each awardee will receive a **one-off scholarship of HUF 250,000**. In addition to the financial award, successful applicants will receive a certificate of recognition.

Submission Deadlines:

Applications may be submitted on a rolling basis within two application periods aligned with the academic semesters:

- For **Semester 1 of 2025/2026**, applications received by **31 January 2026, 15:00** will be evaluated.
- For **Semester 2 of 2025/2026**, applications received by **30 June 2026, 15:00** will be evaluated.

Method of Submission:

Applications may only be submitted online via the following platform: <https://ktr.sze.hu>.

The application form is available under the 'Applications' (Pályázatok) menu and may be completed after logging in using the central directory eduID.
